- 14) The RBI (Reserve Bank of India) on 3<sup>rd</sup>
  June, 2013 increased the validity period of setting up of banks from one year to 18 months.
- Nation's highest Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) will be set up at Nyoma, Leh district at a height of about 14000 feet.
- 16) Korean electronic major Samsung on 12<sup>th</sup>
  June, 2013 launched another handset model
  called Samsung GALAXY Mega.
- Panja Sahib in Pakistan is to be declared a Holy City by Government of Pakistan. Panja Sahib is a house of stone with hand print of Guru Nanak Dev.
- **18) Indian Railway** will start the services of booking travel tickets through **SMS**. The services will start from **July 2013**.
- WPI inflation in May 2013 came down to 4.7 percent against 4.89 percent measured in April 2013.
- 20) The number of Internet users in India is likely to nearly triple from 125 million in 2011 to 330 million by 2016.

- 21) The Union government on 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 almost doubled the price at which natural gas is supposed to be sold to producers of power, fertilizer, minerals and steel.
- 22) The Export Import (EXIM) Bank of India announced on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 that it received a license for opening the representative office in Yangon, Myanmar.
- 23) In June 2013 a fierce cloudburst was witnessed in Uttarakhand resulting in huge damage across the state and hundreds of deaths. Thousands were reported missing and several villages were swept away.
- 24) Union External Affairs Minister, Salman Khurshid visited Iraq from 19<sup>th</sup> June to 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2013. Khurshid is the first Indian Minister to visit Iraq in 23 years.
- 25) CBDT on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 announced that the Commodities Transaction Tax shall be levied on the non-farm products from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2013.
- 26) Nitish Kumar won Vote of Confidence in Bihar Assembly with support of 126 MLAs.
- 27) The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) on 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2013 approved mechanism for coal supply to Power Producers.
- 28) Manmohan Singh and Sonia Gandhi on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 flagged off first train which connects Banihal in Jammu with Qazigund in Kashmir.
- United States Secretary of State John Kerry completed his India visit on 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2013. He was on three-day visit to India from 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2013 to 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2013.
- 30) The World Health Organization introduced new guidelines for the treatment of HIV.
- 31) The white tiger safari was restarted in the Nandankanan Park of Odisha by the Park officials, marking the end of a month's long closure.
- 32) The Union Cabinet of India on 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 approved the Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Bill 2013.

- 60) O3b Networks launched a series of satellites which is supposed to provide fast, cheap Internet and phone service to remote areas in 180 countries.

- **65) CCEA** on **28<sup>th</sup> June**, 2013 approved the **Minimum Support Prices (MSPs)** for **kharif crops** of **2013-14 season**.
- 66) Union Cabinet of India on 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 gave its approval to the proposal for the GSAT-15 communication satellite project.
- 67) The Chief Minister of Uttarakhand announced on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 that the Kedarnath shrine will remain shut down for one year because of heavy damage.
- 68) Andhra Pradesh state Assembly on 19<sup>th</sup>
  June, 2013 passed the bill to restore
  gender balance.
- 69) Tata Power with Geodynamics commissioned a 1 MW geothermal plant in Australia, thereby strengthening the footprint in overseas market.
- 70) Maharashtra Government made possession of UID Number mandatory for the teaching and non-teaching staffs in the state to draw their salary.
- Government proposed sweeping changes in FDI regime to attract foreign investors based on the recommendations made by Arvind Mayaram Committee.

- 72) INS Trikand was commissioned into the Indian Navy on 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 at Kaliningrad, Russia.
- 73) Japanese got its First MOX Nuclear Shipment port since Fukushima on 28th June, 2013 which was arrived from France loaded with reprocessed nuclear fuel.
- 74) The UN Security Council eased sanctions against Iraq imposed after Saddam Hussein's invasion of Kuwait in 1990.
- 75) Union Government on 27th June, 2013 raised the base price of rice to 1310 rupees per 100 kilograms from 1250 rupees as compared to year 2012.
- 76) Indian Space Research Organization scientists will establish navigation satellite system for India like that of America's GPS.
